


While referring to the subject and reference cited, I am, by direction, to inform that the Government have sent the minutes of the review meeting of Hon'ble Chief Minister on Higher and Technical Education held on 11.05.2011 and requested this office to take necessary action on the minutes of the meeting. The minutes on "accreditation of Colleges in the State" read that:

"the Hon'ble Chief Minister has noted that the number of accredited colleges is very less in Andhra Pradesh when compared to other States. It is noted that the accreditation to the Colleges is mandatory in some of the States. It is felt that the Colleges shall be motivated to go for accreditation in Andhra Pradesh also".
