QUESTIONNAIRE

1	Whether the Institution has constituted a proctorial Committee consisting of senior faculty members and hostel authorities like the warden and a few responsible senior students at the commencement of the academic sessions:	
2	Whether the Institution has used posters, Notices Boards and sign-boards to make the students aware of the dehumanizing effect of ragging.	
3	Whether the Institution has constituted a Committee consisting of Parents and guardians of the students taking education in their institute, two representatives of the student union, the Principal and a representative of teaching staff of the said institution.	
4	Whether the meeting of the said committee was held, if so, the date of meeting, recommendations made to the Management and action taken by the management.	
5	Whether the Institution has taken a written undertaking from the candidates and their parents/guardians to the effect that he/she/they is/are aware of the institution's approach towards ragging and punishment to which he or she will be liable if found guilty of ragging.	
6	Whether the Management, Principal, the teaching staff have interacted with the freshers and taken them into confidence by appraising them of their rights as well as obligation to fight against ragging.	
7	Whether the management have provide telephone numbers of Principals, Vice principals, Head of Departments, senior faculty / administrative officers, Warden and Deputy warden, to every new entrant for reporting all incidents of ragging. If yes the details of Cell Phone Nos. be mentioned.	
8	Whether the hostel / accommodation, where freshers are accommodated, are carefully guarded.	

9	Whether the secret student vigilance groups are formed or not. (They are expected to bring to the attention of the Anti-ragging committee any incident of ragging in the college or outside).	
10	Whether complaint boxes are installed at college to receive the complaints of the junior students to know about the ragging incidents, if any.	
11	Whether the Heads of Institution or senior faculty member are making surprise visits to the students hostels, especially in the evening hours, to check incidents of ragging. If so, details thereon.	
12	Whether any link is available in the Official website of the Institution to enable the students to file on line complaints.	
13	Whether the Educational Institutions have engaged professional councilors for seeking assistance at the time of admissions to counsel freshers and seniors and emphasize the importance of developing camaraderie.
