As per G.O. Ms.No.216 cited above, you are requested to take note of the following.

- The private Unaided Engineering including Pharmacy and Architecture colleges are permitted to collect
- Rs.1500/-per annum per student during the course towards the common services rendered by the University to all the Colleges and such amount collected by the college shall be remitted to the concerned university.

In view of the above, the colleges are required to remit an amount of Rs.1500/- towards the common services rendered by the University per candidate of the present second year M.Tech/M.Pharmacy/Pharm D. The requisite fee is to be paid in the form of a consolidated D.D. drawn on any nationalized bank in favor of "Registrar, JNTU Anantapur" payable at Anantapur. The demand draft is to be dated 24.10.2009. The consolidated list of the second year MTech/M.Pharm/Pharm.D students (as per the clearance certificate issued during the time of entry) along with the demand draft (Separate lists and DDs for different courses) should be sent by speed-post/registered post so as to reach the office of the Controller of Examinations by 28.10.2009.
