ORDER:-

As per B.Tech. (NR) regulations, one of the academic requirements for the award of degree is as below:

“1. Award of B.Tech. Degree:

A student will be declared eligible for the award of the B.Tech. Degree if he fulfills the following academic regulations:

- i. He has pursued a course of study for not less than four academic years and not more than eight academic years.
- ii. He has registered for and studied all the subjects for a total of 212 credits and secured all the 212 credits.”

Many representations from the students of this university belonging to NR regulations are received, requesting the University to exempt a few credits for the award of the degree claiming that in spite of their hard work and best effort, they are unable to pass two to three subjects, which are compulsory subjects to become eligible for the award of degree.

In view of the above, as per the resolution of the university officials in the meeting held on 16-06-2011, the Vice Chancellor is pleased to exempt 12 credits from the compulsory credits. The above clause No.1 of NR regulation is here by amended as follows for such students of NR regulation who have a maximum of 3 back log subjects.

“1. Award of B.Tech. Degree:

A student will be declared eligible for the award of the B.Tech. Degree if he fulfills the following academic regulations:

- i. “B. Tech Degree shall be awarded for students under NR academic regulations (i.e, 1999-2000, 2000-01, 2001-02 admitted batches), who have acquired minimum of 200 credits out of 212 credits registered. However, such students will be awarded ‘PASS CLASS’ only, irrespective of the overall aggregate percentage acquired. This amendment is applicable is to only those NR students who have not passed all the subjects which were compulsory as on 16-06-2011.”

This order shall come into force with immediate effect.
